Elective courses for the NNKVO Master's Programme in Physical Geography and Quaternary Geology, 120 credits, study year 2018-2019

Decided by the Head Director of Studies 2018-01-19, after consultancy with the department's educational advisory group.

Within the program (from autumn term 2017), 22.5 credits courses must be chosen from a list of elective courses in Physical Geography and Quaternary Geology. The following courses constitute this list for the study year 2018-2019:

- GE8021 Quaternary Geology, Specialized Course, 7.5 credits
- GE8022 Physical Geography, Specialized Course, 7.5 credits
